**Potholes** – It was noted at the last meeting that there are a number of potholes on the old road at the top of the Village that have not been marked for filling. The Clerk confirmed that Gloucestershire Highways have been informed.

#### 8. Chairman's Report

Cllr Mrs J Tomblin reported that:

- during the weekend before Christmas she had received a complaint about the Big Yellow Bus parked in Village Farm yard. The Chairman advised the complainant that it was not a matter that the Parish Council could deal with and that they should contact the landowner, but it was understood that the bus would be moved once volunteers had finished work on it.
- a local landowner had complained that the spray used on Japanese knotweed may have damaged a hedge. It was confirmed that this matter had been referred to Gloucestershire Highways.
- the driveway at Wychwood does not conform to the planning application and a resident has advised CDC Planners who were unconcerned.
- the planner working with the owner of Wildwood had advised that further development on the site had raised issues from Planners and the EA.

#### 9. Playing Field – Cllr G Edwards

Action: It was agreed that the Chairman would carry out safety checks on the Playing Field.

JT & CB Cllr Price confirmed that the holes on the Playing Field have been filled. It was further noted that the Field contains mainly weeds that need spraying in the spring to kill them off and give the grass a chance to recover but may also need re-seeding. It would NP cost £100 to re-seed and it was agreed to do this, if necessary, in the spring.
