# NEWS FROM ALL SAINTS CHURCH

Letter from the Vicar:

This year is one in which Remembrance Sunday actually falls on November 11th and so when we meet for the service on Sunday morning we shall keep the silence on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month. It is good for our community and our nation that Remembrance Sunday is observed by so many, even though those with direct memories of the last world war are fewer each year. I'm sure that this is partly because of the casualties from our armed forces we continue to hear about in Afghanistan, but I think it is also that we continue to recognise that it is important to remember our history and the human cost of the freedom we enjoy. One of the aspects I always find moving is the thought that behind each of the names we remember there is a unique personality and life story, as well as hopes and dreams of the future, a future sacrificed for us.

The service at Preston Church on November 11th will include the act of remembrance and you are welcome to join us as we meet to remember and to pray for a peaceful world.

Another, more personal, act of remembrance that takes place in November is All Souls Day, the day in the Church calendar when we think about those who have died and pray for all who are bereaved. Our Benefice All Souls Service this year at All Hallows at South Cerney is at 3pm on Saturday, November 3rd. The service is followed by tea and you are very welcome to come and join us.
